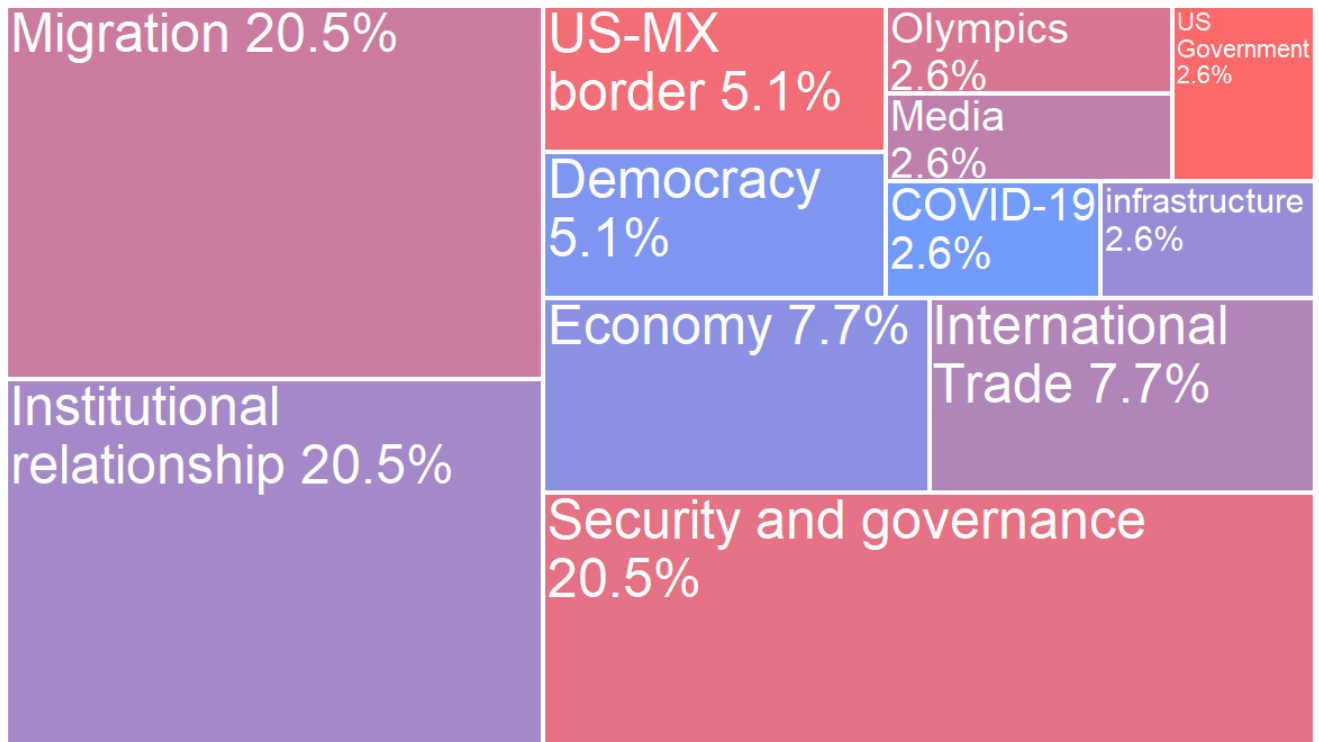
Coverage Report

July 31st to August 15th 2021

During this period, 39 publications were compiled regarding the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States. Of the total publications, 23 were made by Mexican Think Tanks, while the remaining 16 were done by United States Think Tanks. *The Mexican Council for International Affairs* (COMEXI) was the Think Tank with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 21 publications, followed by the *Mexico Institute* with 4 publications and the *Baker Institute* with 3 publications.

During this period, three main topics were discussed, the most mentioned topics were **Institutional Relations, Migration, Security and governance** followed by **International Trade** and **Economy**. Thirdly, **Democracy** and **US-MX border**. Additionally, various topics appeared in the publications such as **Covid-19 Vaccine, Infrastructure, Media, and US Government**, among others.
