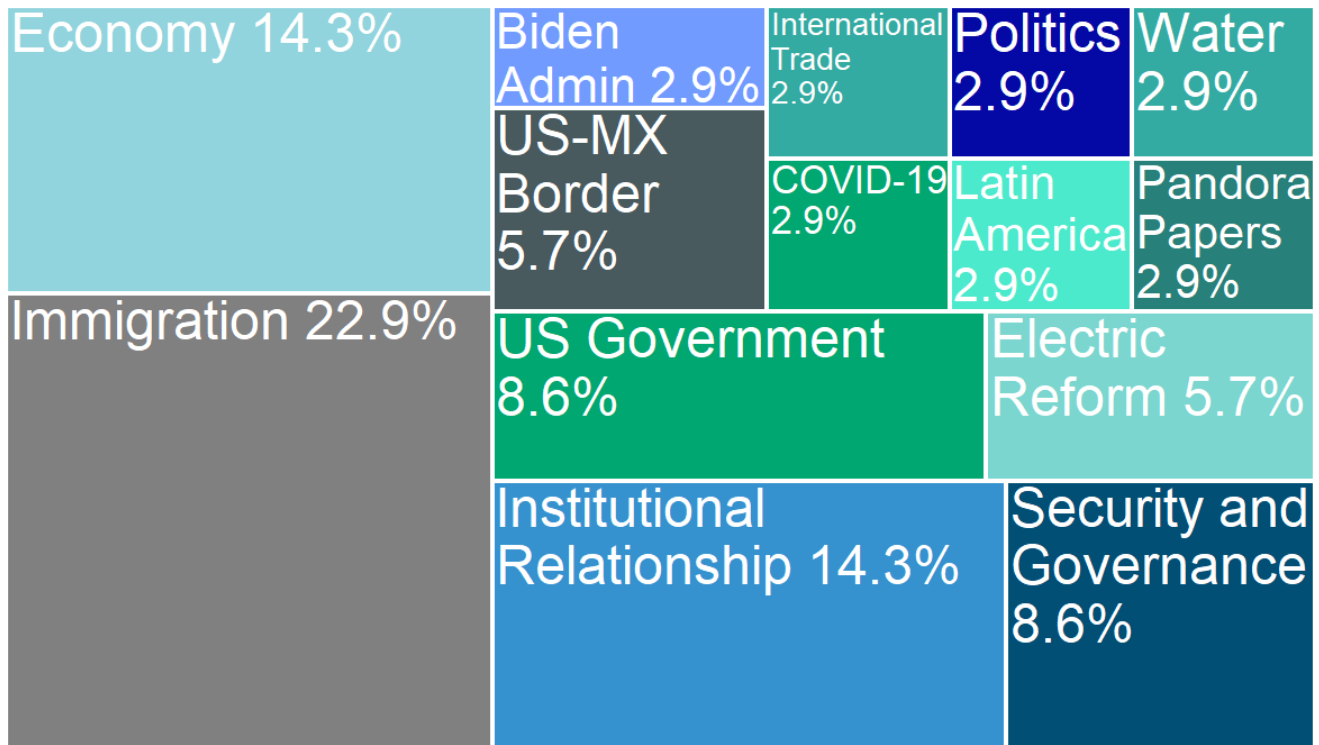
Coverage Report

October 15th to 31st of 2021

During the period, 35 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 16 of the publications were made by think tanks in Mexico, while 19 publications were made by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales* (COMEXI) was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 16 publications, followed by the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) with 6 publications and the Baker Institute with 5 publications.

Three main topics were discussed, the most mentioned topic was: **Migration**. Followed by: **Institutional Relationship** and **Economy**. Additionally, the topics of: **Security and Governance**, **US Government**, **US and Mexico Border**, and **Mexico’s Electricity Reform** were highlighted. Finally, the topics of: **Biden Administration**, **International Trade**, **Politics**, **Pandora Papers**, **COVID-19**, **Latin America** and **Water** were mentioned.
