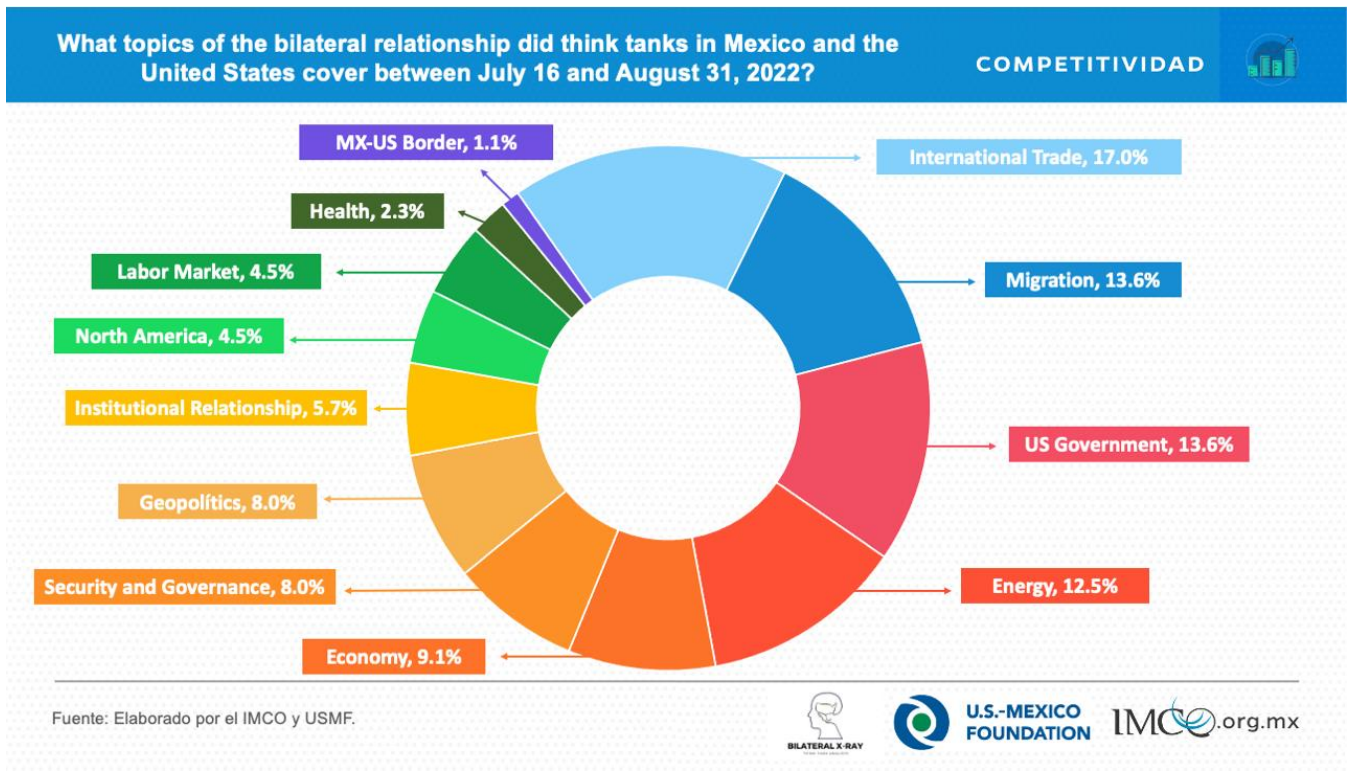
Coverage Report

July 16th to August 31st 2022

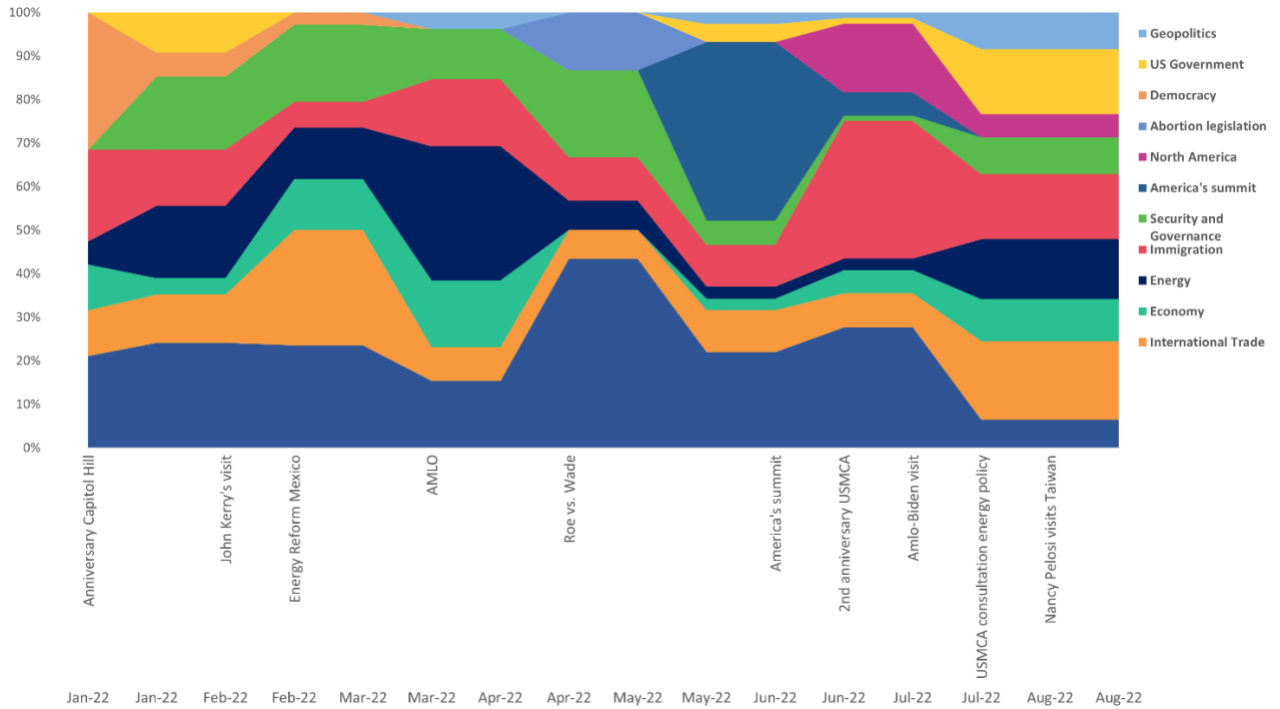
We compiled eighty-seven publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States during the period. Sixty of the total publications were made by Mexican think tanks, while 27 publications were produced by the United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales* (COMEXI) was the leading institution with the most publications with 42, followed by the *Instituto Mexicano para la Competitividad* (IMCO) with 12 publications and the Baker Institute with seven publications.

The main topic was international trade, focusing mainly on the requests for dispute settlement consultations with Mexico over its energy policy under the USMCA's provisions. Then immigration featured a record number of remittances and bilateral labor opportunities. Similarly, the US Government focuses on the FBI investigation in Mar-a-Lago, home of former President Donald Trump, and in the upcoming midterm elections, which will define the control of the Congress by the Republican or Democratic party. Some other topics were energy, economy, monetary policy, and inflationary pressures. Also, think tanks discussed geopolitics due to the growing tensions between China and the United States and Nancy Pelosi's visit to Taiwan. Finally, other topics discussed include the labor market, security and governance, North America, and the US-Mexico border.

The chart above shows the most popular subjects for each month. The topics constantly appearing are international trade, institutional relations, energy, economy, security and governance, and migration. Additionally, short-term events usually generate a more significant number of publications, as can be seen with the following topics: the US government, with multiple articles mentioning Trump and the investigation in Mar-a-Lago, as well as the upcoming elections between Republicans and Democrats. Furthermore, with the growing tensions between China and the US, geopolitics was followed by the think tanks due to Nancy Pelosi's visit to Taiwan.
