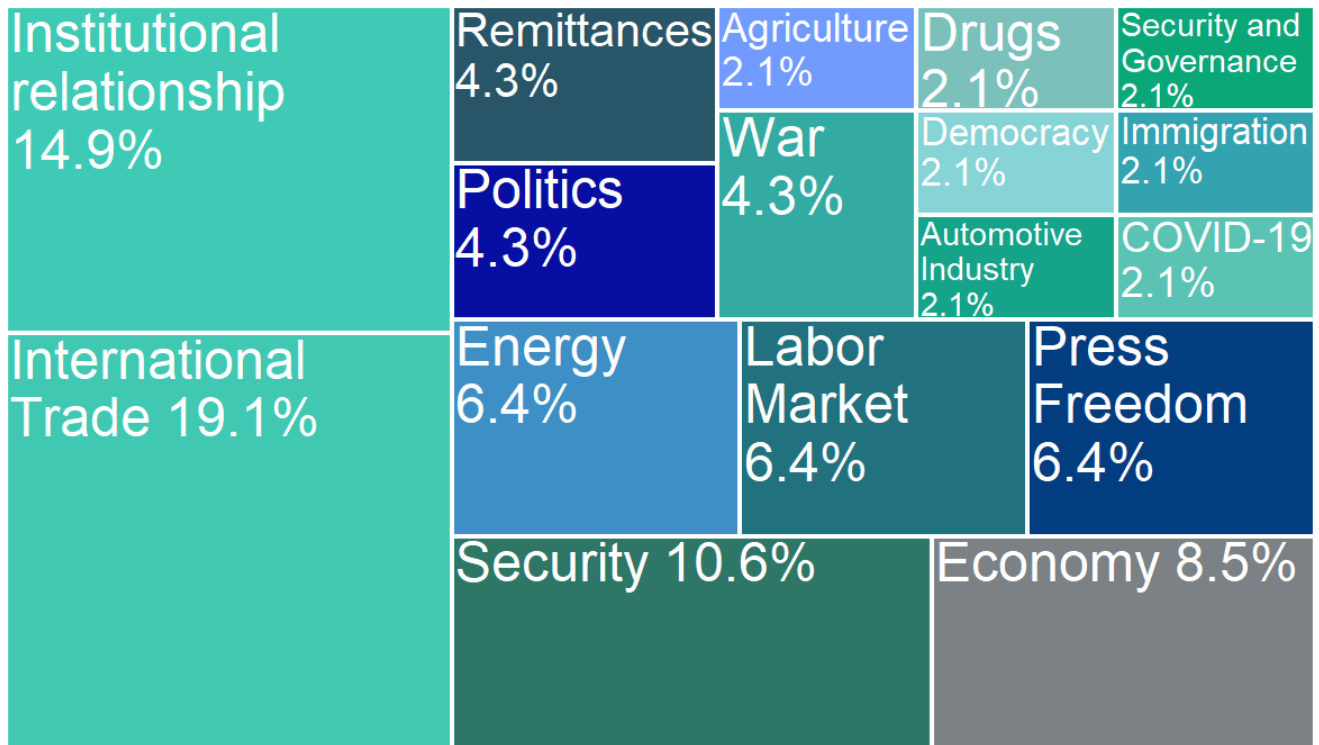
Coverage Report

February 15th to March 15th 2022

During the period, 47 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 14 of the publications were made by think tanks in Mexico, while 33 publications were made by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales (COMEXI)* was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 12 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute and Brookings Institutions with 10 and 9 publications respectively.

Three main topics were discussed during the period. The most mentioned was **international trade**, regarding the USMCA, followed by **institutional relationship** and **security**, discussing topics such as violence against journalists, drugs and arms trafficking. **Energy**, in relationship to Mexico’s energy reform, as well as the **economy**, **freedom of press** and the **labor market** with its challenges and opportunities and how **immigration** plays a major role. Finally, the topics of **drugs**, **remittances**, **politics**, **agriculture**, the **automotive industry**, the war **Russia and Ukraine**, among others, were discussed.
